TAM receives EASA Production Organisation Approval

Örebro, Sweden: Täby Air Maintenance, TAM, has been given an EASA Production Organisation Approval Certificate, POA, meaning that TAM now is fully authorised to manufacture parts and appliances for their well reputed Saab 340 A/B cargo conversion design as well as other new projects.
