TAM: Additional Saab 340B Cargo Conversion delivered

Örebro, Sweden: Continuing its successful series of Saab 340B Cargo Conversions, an additional aircraft – ES-NSD, s/n 171 – was delivered this week in a striking “branded livery” to Estonian airline Nyx Air.

With a firm experience from converting more than a dozen Saab 340s to full cargo configuration, the TAM cargo conversions meet an increased market interest, with ES-NSD being the second aircraft delivered from TAM’s Örebro workshops in 2021.

- We are pleased to see an increasing interest in general for our cargo conversions, with the Saab 340 being the perfect feeder platform for express cargo carriers as well as other short haul cargo operators, says Pär Gulle, TAM Managing Director.
- I am glad to say that we have all reason to expect to deliver 6-8 cargo converted Saab 340s in 2021, up from earlier predicted 4-6 conversions, Pär Gulle states.
